"Recollections of On the Border"

We the Hoosiers wanted an article on Amnesty/Immigration/aliens, so here's a true story about those aliens, the illegal kind that is. Depending on who you listen to or what program you are watching the number changes frequently, but what they don't tell you is that every year new legal illegals come into the

country. The reason I use the term Illegal Legal is due to the fact that they change from a lawful status to one of being unlawfully in the US. That is the dirty little secret, a significant segment of that large number don't sneak into the country we let them in .I used to be a Border Patrol Agent working on the southern border just north of Tijuana, Mexico, in a small town called San Ysidro, CA which is just south of San Diego,CA.

Someone once asked me, how many aliens did you catch in your Border Patrol Career? I answered in the thousands and he didn't believe me. While testifying in a detention hearing a Defense attorney asked me that question and that was my answer. The attorney was questioning my expertise relating to illegal aliens and their ties to the community. I crunched the number for the judge right there and then and that number just shut the defense attorney down. You ask, how can that be, one agent arresting that many illegal aliens. The answer is: I spent approx. 5 years working the border, Five years times 50 weeks per year, that's 250 weeks. Then 250 weeks times 5 workdays per week that comes to 1 250 days worked on the border. Just two arrest per day and there's your thousands.

Now I'm not kidding but in those days you really would have had to work hard not to catch anybody, in fact there were times when you encountered aliens hungry, hot and exhausted from their journey and they would surrender to you It was not uncommon to come upon small groups of two or three but most of the time , especially at night the groups were larger 10, 20, 30 or more, if you've ever seen the movie "Born in East LA" there is a scene when the illegal's waiting to enter the US just charge the border, hundreds, those types of charges really happened. But don't ask me what I did.

I truly enjoyed my job in those days. I had no problem going out and giving promotion/information speeches for the border Patrol at the local schools. Today, working as a Border Patrol Agent, I just don't know, but what comes to mind is the story of two Border Patrol Agents, Ignacio Ramos and Jose Campeon. Both were charged and convicted of assault and civil rights violations on an undocumented *illegal alien drug smuggler*. Ramos and Campeon, spent time in jail and their sentences were finally commuted by President Bush on his last day in Office. Back in those bygone days, when there weren't fancy remote controlled aircraft and radar towers with cameras you had to catch the illegals the old fashioned way. When I could, I would take a walk, especially in the canyons near the actual border and the more remote areas of the nearby hill country the border ran through. Most times I would never be able to finish my walk due to encountering illegal aliens and having to stop, take them into custody, process them and eventually have them returned to Mexico.

I have often wondered what ever happened to some of those aliens that I used to send back to Mexico. Well guess what? They are probably part of the 12-20 million estimated to be in the United States now. Back in those days we had a saying. If you don't see him (the illegal alien) again then he probably made it into the United States.

This was to be a piece on Amnesty and it sort of was. Let me end by saying this ex Border Patrol Agent is against Amnesty. Think about this, unemployment rate 9.7%, 14.5 million Americans out of work. Don't you think that instead of legalizing another 12-20 million workers into the legal labor force you should open up and convert those jobs through deportation and removal.
